The Director of Ontario Regulation 217/01 (Liquid Fuels) pursuant to section 7 of Ontario Regulation 223/01 (Codes and Standards Adopted by Reference) hereby provides notice of the following:

The Liquid Fuels Handling Code Adoption Document published by the Technical Standards and Safety Authority, dated June 1, 2001, and amended on June 1, 2007 is further amended as follows:

- Clause 5.5.10 is added:
 5.5.10 All marinas shall be full-serve facilities.
- 2. This amendment is effective June 30, 2008.

Background:

Clause 5.5.9 provides that:

At each marina there shall be three legible signs, visible to all persons using the dispensers...one sign shall read "WARNING – NO ONE OTHER THAN THE FUEL ATTENDANT SHALL BE ON BOARD A WATERCRAFT DURING REFUELING."

As a result, clause 5.5.10 is added to clarify the requirement that all marinas shall be full-serve facilities.
